	Order packing materials (cases, boxes etc.) and arrange a removal firm if you're using one	Pack an overnight bag with essentials for the first day in your new home
	Start packing non-essential items	Box up your remaining items. Leave the kettle on top so you can make a cuppa when you arrive in your new kitchen!
	Find a new school for your children (if necessary) and arrange to transfer school records	Marina day
	Book the days needed off work to move	Moving day
	Start getting rid of possessions and furniture you no longer need	Take a note of your final meter readings in your old home Make sure all windows and doors are locked and that you've
		not left anything behind

	Arrange for your mail to be redirected	If you're renting, inspect the new property and identify any damage or issues you may need to raise with the landlord/agents
	Start to use up any food in your freezer	Take photos as appropriate
	Arrange the utilities in your new home – gas, electricity, broadband, telephone. Don't forget to shop around for the best deal	Take the meter readings of the new property
	Let friends and family know about your change of address	Leave a contact address with the occupants or letting agents of your old house, in case they want to forward on any post
	Sort out care for your children and pets on moving day

	Arrange your contents insurance for your new home	
	If you're moving to a city with parking restrictions, apply	Update the electoral register
	for your on-street parking permit	Register with a doctor and dentist (if necessary)

	Thoroughly clean your old home and tidy the garden	
	Let your current council know you're moving, and speak to the new council to arrange payment of Council Tax (if necessary)

	If you're renting, take detailed photos of each room and area, covering any wear and tear you're concerned might cause issues with your deposit
